PURCHASE ORDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms are for use with straightforward purchases of goods and services typically below the EU threshold.

TERMS AND CONDITONS FOR THE SUPPLY OF GOODS AND/OR SERVICES

1. **DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

In these Terms and Conditions, the following definitions apply: 1.1

"Deliverables" means all Documents, products and materials developed by the Supplier or its agents, contractors and employees as part of or in relation to the Services in any form, including without limitation computer programs, data, reports and specifications (including drafts);

"Document" means in addition to any document in writing, includes (but is not limited to) any drawing, map, plan, diagram, design, picture or other image, tape, disk or other device or record embodying information in any form:

"Goods" means the goods described in the Purchase Order:

"Key Personnel" means any person named on the Purchase Order as key personnel or any person who Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. notifies the Supplier is to be regarded as key personnel during the provision of the Services;

- "Order Number" means the unique number that appears on the Purchase Order;
- "Parties" means Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. and the Supplier;

"Premises" means any land or building where the Goods are to be delivered and/or the Services are to be performed as specified in the Purchase Order or as otherwise notified by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to the Supplier; "Price" means the price for the goods given in the Purchase Order;

"Purchase Order" means an order for the purchase of Goods and/or Services served by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. on the Supplier which includes a description of the Goods and/or Services, the price and any terms applying to the purchase of the Goods and/or Services which are additional to these Terms and Conditions;

"Services" means the services described in the Purchase Order (and including (but not limited to) any Deliverables to be provided by the Supplier under the Contract as set out in the Specification);

Specification" means in relation to Goods, any specification for the Goods (including any relevant plans or drawings) provided by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to the Supplier; and, in relation to Services, the description or specification for Services produced by the Supplier and agreed in writing by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd;

"Supplier" means the person, firm or company whose name appears as the addressee in the Purchase Order; and "Terms and Conditions" means these terms and conditions for the supply of Goods and/or Services.

- In these Terms and Conditions, the following rules apply: a) a person includes a natural person, corporate or unincorporated body (whether or not having separate legal personality);
 - references to a party includes its successors or permitted assigns; b)
 - a reference to a statute or statutory provision is a reference to such statute or statutory provision as amended or re-C) enacted. A reference to a statute or statutory provision includes any subordinate legislation made under that statute or statutory provision, as amended or re-enacted; and
 - any phrase introduced by the terms including, include, in particular or any similar expression shall be construed as d) illustrative and shall not limit the sense of the words preceding those terms.

GENERAL 2.

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- 21 The Purchase Order constitutes an offer by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to purchase Goods and/or Services from the Supplier in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. 2.2
 - The offer shall be deemed to be accepted by the Supplier on the earlier of:
 - the Supplier issuing written acceptance of the Purchase Order; or a)
 - any act by the Supplier consistent with fulfilling the Purchase Order, b)
 - at which point and on which date a contract (the "Contract") shall become effective (the "Effective Date").

These Terms and Conditions apply to the Contract the exclusion of any other terms that the Supplier seeks to impose or 2.3 incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.

- Subject to clause 11.3, the Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties relating to the supply of the Goods 2.4 and/or Services and replaces all previous negotiations, agreements, understandings and representations whether oral or in writing. However nothing in the Contract shall limit or exclude any liability for fraud.
- All of the Terms and Conditions shall apply to the supply of both Goods and Services except where the application to one or the 2.5 other is specified.
- In the event of any conflict between a clause in these Terms and Conditions and a term of the Purchase Order, the term of the 2.6 Purchase Order shall prevail.

3. SUPPLY OF GOODS

- The Supplier shall supply the Goods in accordance with the Purchase Order. 3.1
- The Goods shall comply with both the Supply of Goods and Services Act 1982 (as amended) and Sale of Goods Act 1979 (as 32 amended) and:
 - be to the reasonable satisfaction of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd; a)
 - b) be fit and sufficient for all purposes for which such Goods are generally used and for any specific purpose made known to the Supplier by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd;
 - be of the same quality and description as any sample provided; C)
 - where applicable, be free from defects in design, materials and workmanship and remain so for 12 months after d) delivery: and
 - comply with any requirements given on the Purchase Order and/or any Specification. e)

DELIVERY OF GOODS 4.

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- The Supplier shall deliver the Goods to the address for delivery given in the Purchase Order. 4.1
 - Where the Supplier requires access to the Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s Premises in order to deliver the Goods: the Supplier shall agree delivery times with Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. in advance (unless they agree a). otherwise)
 - the Supplier shall comply with any rules or security requirements applied by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. in b). relation to access to its Premises.

- Except where otherwise agreed by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, delivery of the Goods shall include unloading the Goods at 4.3 such place and in such manner as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall reasonably direct.
- The Supplier shall deliver the Goods on or (where Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. agrees) before the date or dates given in the 44 Purchase Order. Unless the Purchase Order provides otherwise, the time of delivery is of the essence in this Contract and any failure to deliver the Goods by the date (or at the time) given in the Purchase Order shall entitle Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to give the Supplier notice terminating the Contract with immediate effect.
- Without prejudice to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s other rights and remedies under this Contract, property and risk in the 45 Goods shall pass to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. on acceptance of delivery.
- Any consignment of Goods dispatched by the Supplier for delivery to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall be accompanied by 4.6 a delivery note prepared by the Supplier marked with the Order Number. Where applicable, the delivery note shall also specify the means of transport, the place and date of delivery, the number of packages, the content of the packages, the weight and volume of the packages and whether or not the packaging must be returned to the Supplier.
- The Goods shall be appropriately packaged and clearly labelled. The labelling and packaging shall comply with any reasonable 4.7 requirements of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. of which the Supplier is aware and with any statutory requirements. In particular, if the packages contain any material which is hazardous, noxious or dangerous this shall be clearly indicated.
- All packaging shall be considered non-returnable and shall be destroyed unless the Supplier indicates in the advice note 4.8 accompanying the consignment of Goods that the packaging will be charged for unless it is returned. Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall only accept liability for packaging that does not arrive at the Supplier's premises following dispatch by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. if the Supplier informs Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. of its non-arrival within 10 days of receiving notification from Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. that the packaging has been despatched.
- Where some or all of the Goods have been damaged in transit (or have failed to arrive at Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. after 49 dispatch by the Supplier) the Supplier shall either repair or replace the Goods in question (at the choice of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd) provided always that:
 - in the case of damage in transit Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. has informed the Supplier of the damage within 30 a) days of receiving the Goods; and
 - in the case of non-delivery and where the Supplier has notified Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. of the Intended date b) of delivery, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. has informed the Supplier within 10 days of the notified delivery date that the Goods have not been received.
- The Supplier shall permit Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to inspect the Goods and shall provide all reasonable assistance to 4.10 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. in undertaking an inspection.
- 4.11 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall not be taken to have waived any of its rights under this Contract (and in particular its right to reject the Goods) if it does not carry an inspection or if it approves the Goods following an inspection.
- Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may, by written notice to the Supplier, reject any of the Goods which fail to meet the 4.12 requirements of this Contract provided always that Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. gives such notice within a reasonable time of receiving the Goods.
- If Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. rejects any of the Goods pursuant to this clause, it shall be entitled: 4.13
 - to have the Goods concerned either repaired by the Supplier or (at the choice of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd) a) replaced by the Supplier with Goods which comply with this Contract; or b)
 - to obtain a refund of any payment it has made to the Supplier.
- Subject to any alternative guarantee arrangements made between Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. and the Supplier, the 4.14 guarantee period applicable to the Goods shall be 12 months from Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. putting the Goods into service or 18 months from delivery (whichever is shorter).
- If, within the guarantee period or within 30 days thereafter, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. gives the Supplier written notice of 4.15 any defect which arose within the guarantee period under proper and normal use of the Goods, the Supplier shall remedy such defect as quickly as possible (whether by repair or replacement, as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall choose) without cost to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- Any Goods rejected or returned to the Supplier shall be returned at the Supplier's expense. 4.16
- 4.17 Where the Purchase Order requires the Supplier to install the Goods at the Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s Premises:
 - the Supplier shall make no delivery of plant, materials or equipment and shall not commence any installation work a) without the prior consent of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd;
 - the Supplier shall carry out the installation work diligently and with reasonable skill and care; b)
 - the Supplier shall comply with Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s requirements relating to access to and use of its c) Premises and shall co-ordinate its work with any other employee or contractor who is carrying out work for Advanced Witness Systems Ltd;
 - d) the Supplier shall keep Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s Premises clean and tidy at all times and shall remove all plant and unused materials when the installation work is complete.
- Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall have the power at any time during any installation works to give notice to the Supplier 4.18 requiring:
 - the removal from its premises of any materials which are hazardous or noxious or not in accordance with the a) Contract:
 - b) the substitution of proper and suitable materials; and/or
 - the removal and re-execution of any installation work or any Goods which are not in accordance with the Contract. c)

5. SUPPLY OF SERVICES

- The Supplier shall provide the Services set out in the Purchase Order. 5.1
- 5.1.1 In performing the Services the Supplier will be an independent contractor and nothing in the Contract shall render the Supplier, or any of its staff, an employee, worker, agent or partner of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. and the Supplier (and shall procure that anyone providing the Services) shall not hold itself out as such.
- The Supplier shall perform the Services: 52
 - with reasonable care and diligence; a)
 - in accordance with industry best practice and using the best available techniques and standards; b)
 - using staff who have appropriate skills, qualifications and experience; c)
 - d) using the appropriate number of staff;
 - in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations and all necessary licences and consents (and including, where e) reasonably required by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, any security policies of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd); and f) to the reasonable satisfaction.
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- 5.3 The Supplier shall provide all plant, equipment and materials necessary for the performance of the Services except as otherwise agreed with Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. All plant, equipment and materials shall be at the Supplier's risk. The Price shall include the costs of haulage of plant, equipment and material to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s Premises and their removal and 'making good' the Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. premises after removal after the Services are complete.
 5.4 The Supplier shall not place or cause to be placed any orders with third parties or otherwise incur any liabilities to third parties in
- 5.4 The Supplier shall not place or cause to be placed any orders with third parties or otherwise incur any liabilities to third parties in the name of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. without the prior written consent of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 5.5 The Supplier shall carry out the Services for the period and/or in accordance with the timescales set out in the Purchase Order. Unless the Purchase Order provides otherwise, the time of delivery of the service is of the essence in this Contract and any failure to deliver the service by the date (or at the time) given in the Purchase Order shall entitle Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to give the Supplier notice terminating the Contract with immediate effect.
- 5.6 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may by written notice require the Supplier to execute the Services in such order as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may reasonably decide. In the absence of such notice the Supplier shall submit such detailed programmes of work and progress reports as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may from time to time require.
- 5.7 The Supplier shall notify Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. immediately if it becomes aware of any event that it believes is likely to delay or impede the performance of the Services.
- 5.8 In the event that the Supplier fails to meet a date or dates set out in the Purchase Order it shall, on the request of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, and without prejudice to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s other rights and remedies, arrange to provide all such additional resources as are necessary to fulfil its obligations at no additional cost to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 5.9 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may at any time reject the Services or anything delivered as part of the Services which in the reasonable view of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. does not comply with the Purchase Order or these Terms and Conditions in any material way.
- 5.10 If Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. rejects all or part of the Services under clause 5.9, it shall serve a notice on the Supplier stating the reasons for such rejection.
- 5.11 Following receipt of a notice of rejection of the Services, the Supplier shall have 7 days (or such other period as the Parties may agree in writing) during which the Supplier shall correct the faults which caused the notice of rejection to be issued.
- 5.12 If the Supplier fails to correct the faults which caused the notice of rejection to be issued to the reasonable satisfaction of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. within 7 days, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall be entitled to terminate this Contract or any part of the Services.
- 5.13 The Supplier shall remove and/or re-execute (at the choice of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd) any work that has been rejected by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 5.14 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may require the immediate removal from its premises of anything delivered by the Supplier which, in the reasonable view of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, is hazardous or noxious. The Supplier shall comply with any such request at its own expense.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

6.1 Neither party shall be liable in respect of any breach of this Contract due to any cause beyond its reasonable control including Act of God, inclement weather, flood, lightening or fire, the act or omission of Government, highway authorities or other competent authority, war, military operations or riot.

7. CONTRACTOR'S PERSONNEL

- 7.1 The Supplier shall make Key Personnel available for the purposes of the Services and shall not make any changes in the Key Personnel without the prior written approval of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 7.2 If and when requested by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, the Supplier shall provide Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. with a list of the names and addresses of any person being used to provide the Services specifying, in each case, the capacities in which they are involved and giving such other particulars and evidence of identity and other supporting evidence as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may reasonably require.
- 7.3 The Supplier shall comply with any notice reasonably given by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. stating that a person named in the notice is not to be involved any further in the provision of the Services. The Supplier shall replace any such person with someone of equivalent skills and qualifications.
- 7.4 The Supplier shall not unlawfully discriminate within the meaning and scope of the provisions of any act of Parliament relating to discrimination in employment. The Supplier shall take all reasonable steps to secure the observance of these provisions by all servants, sub-contractors or agents of the Supplier.

8. ADVANCED WITNESS SYSTEMS LTD.'S OBLIGATIONS

8.1 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall:

- a) provide the Supplier with reasonable access at reasonable times to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s premises for the purpose of delivery of the Goods and/or providing the Services; and
- a) provide such information as the Supplier may reasonably request for the provision of the Goods and/or Services and Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. considers reasonably necessary for the purpose of providing the Goods and/or Services.

9. CHARGES AND PAYMENT

9.1 The price for the Goods:

shall be the price set out in the Purchase Order, or if no price is quoted, the price set out in the Supplier's published price list in force at the Effective Date; and shall be inclusive of the costs of packaging, insurance and carriage of the Goods, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. No extra charges shall be effective unless agreed in writing and signed by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.

- 9.2 The charges for the Services shall be set out in the Purchase Order, and shall be the full and exclusive remuneration of the Supplier in respect of the performance of the Services. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, the charges shall include every cost and expense of the Supplier directly or indirectly incurred in connection with the performance of the Services.
- 9.3 In respect of Goods, the Supplier shall invoice Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. on or at any time after completion of delivery. In respect of Services, the Supplier shall invoice Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. on completion of the Services. Each invoice shall include such supporting information required by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to verify the accuracy of the invoice, including but not limited to the relevant Order Number. Invoices shall be addressed to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. at the address set out on the Purchase Order.

- 9.4 In consideration of the supply of Goods and/or Services by the Supplier, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall pay the invoiced amounts within 30 days of the date of receipt of a correctly rendered invoice to a bank account nominated in writing by the Supplier, unless stated otherwise on the Purchase Order.
- 9.5 All amounts payable by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. under the Contract are exclusive of amounts in respect of valued added tax chargeable from time to time ("VAT"). Where any taxable supply for VAT purposes is made under the Contract by the Supplier to the Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, they shall, on receipt of a valid VAT invoice from the Supplier, pay to the Supplier such additional amounts in respect of VAT as are chargeable on the supply of the Goods and/or Services at the same time as payment is due for the supply of the Goods and/or Services.
- 9.6 The Supplier shall maintain complete and accurate records of the time spent and materials used by the Supplier in providing the Services, and the Supplier shall allow Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to inspect such records at all reasonable times on request.
- 9.7 The Supplier shall not be entitled to assert any credit, set-off or counterclaim against Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. in order to justify withholding payment of any such amount in whole or in part. Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may, without limiting its other rights or remedies, set off any amount owing to it by the Supplier against any amount payable by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. to the Supplier.

10. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 10.1 The intellectual property rights (including the copyright) in any reports, documentation or materials produced as part of the Goods and/or Services (including for the avoidance of doubt the Deliverables) are hereby assigned to and shall vest in Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 10.2 Save where the Goods and/or Services use documentation and materials supplied by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, the Supplier warrants that none of the documentation and materials used or created as part of the Goods and/or Services shall infringe any patent, trade mark, registered design, copyright or other rights in industrial property of any third party.
- 10.3 The Supplier shall obtain waivers of all moral rights in the products (including for the avoidance of doubt the Deliverables) of the Services to which any individual is now or may be at any future time entitled under Chapter IV of Part I of the Copyright Designs and Patents Act 1988 or any similar provisions of law in any jurisdiction.
- 10.4 The Supplier shall, promptly at Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.'s request, do (or procure to be done) all such further acts and things and the execution of all such other documents as Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may from time to time require for the purpose of securing for Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. the full benefit of the Contract, including all right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property Rights assigned to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. in accordance with this clause 9.
- 10.5 The Supplier shall indemnify Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. against all actions, demands, charges, expenses and costs (including legal costs on a solicitor and client basis) which the Authority may incur as a result of or in connection with any breach of this clause 9.
- 10.6 This clause shall survive the termination of the Contract.

11. HEALTH AND SAFETY

- 11.1 The Supplier warrants and represents that:
 - a) it has satisfied itself that all necessary examinations have been made prior to delivery of the Goods to ensure that the Goods are designed and constructed so that they can be used without risk to health and safety and
 - b) that it has made available to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. adequate information about any conditions necessary to ensure the Goods can be used safely and without risk to health.
- 11.2 The Supplier shall indemnify Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. against all actions, demands, charges, expenses and costs (including legal costs on a solicitor and client basis) which Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may incur as a result of or in connection with any breach of clause 10.1.
- 11.3 The Supplier shall notify Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. of any health and safety hazards that may arise in connection with the performance of this Contract.
- 11.4 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall notify the Supplier of any health and safety hazards which may exist or arise at its premises and which may affect the Supplier. The Supplier shall draw these hazards to the attention of any of its employees, subcontractors or agents who may be affected by them and instruct such persons in connection with any necessary safety measures.
- 11.5 Where the Services are being carried out at land or premises owned or occupied by Advanced Witness Systems Ltd, shall notify the Supplier of any health and safety hazards which may exist or arise at its premises and which may affect the Supplier. The Supplier shall draw these hazards to the attention of any of its employees, subcontractors or agents who may be affected by them and instruct such persons in connection with any necessary safety measures.

12. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 12.1 Subject to clause 20, the Supplier undertakes to keep secret and not to disclose and to procure that its employees, subcontractors and agents keep secret and do not disclose any information of a confidential nature which it has obtained by reason of this Contract. Nothing in this clause applies to information that is already in the public domain or the possession of the Supplier other than by reason of breach of this clause.
- 12.2 Clause 11.2 shall not apply where the Supplier has entered (or shall enter) into a separate agreement with Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. regarding the confidentiality or non-disclosure of information (a "Confidentiality Agreement") and the terms of such Confidentiality Agreement shall apply to this Contract.
- 12.3 This clause shall survive the termination of the Contract.

13. INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE

- 13.1 Without prejudice to any rights or remedies of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. the Supplier shall indemnify Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. against all actions, demands, losses, expenses and costs (including legal costs on a solicitor and client basis) which Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may suffer or incur as a result of or in connection with any damage to property or any injury (whether fatal or otherwise) to any person which may result directly or indirectly from any defect in the Goods or any negligence or breach of this Contract by the Supplier.
- 13.2 The Supplier warrants that it has in place with a reputable insurance company a policy or policies of insurance covering all the indemnities under this Contract. At the request of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. the Supplier shall produce the relevant policy of insurance together with evidence of payment of its latest premium.
- 13.3 This clause 13 shall survive the termination of the Contract.

14. CHANGE CONTROL

- 14.1 There shall be no change to the amount of or description of the Goods and/or Services or the Price unless Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. has issued a new purchase order in substitution for the Purchase Order. These Terms and Conditions shall apply to any new purchase order and the new purchase order shall become the "Purchase Order" for the purpose of this Contract from the moment it is received by the Supplier.
- 14.2 This Contract may not be varied or amended unless the variation or amendment is in writing and agreed by both Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. and the Supplier.

15. ASSIGNMENT AND SUB-CONTRACTING

- 15.1 The Supplier shall not assign, transfer, charge, subcontract or deal in any other manner with all or any of its rights or obligations under the Contract without the prior written consent of Advanced Witness Systems Ltd.
- 15.2 No sub-contracting of this Contract shall in any way relieve the Supplier of its obligations under the Contract.
- 15.3 Where the Supplier enters a sub-contract with a supplier or contractor for the purpose of performing this Contract it shall ensure that the sub-contract has a term requiring the Supplier to pay the supplier or contractor within 30 days of receipt of a valid invoice.
- 15.4 Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may at any time assign, transfer, charge, subcontract, or deal in any other manner with all or any of its rights under the Contract and may subcontract or delegate in any manner any or all of its obligations under the Contract to any third party or agent.

16. CONTRACTS (RIGHTS OF THIRD PARTIES) ACT 1999

16.1 A person who is not a party to the Contract shall not have any rights under or in connection with it.

17. TERMINATION

- 17.1 Without limiting its other rights or remedies, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may terminate the Contract with immediate effect by giving written notice to the Supplier if:
 - a) the Supplier commits a material or persistent breach of the Contract and (if such a breach is remediable) fails to remedy that breach within 10 days of receipt of notice in writing of the breach;
 - b) the Supplier suspends, or threatens to suspend, payment of its debts or is unable to pay its debts as they fall due or admits inability to pay its debts or (being a company) is deemed unable to pay its debts within the meaning of section 123 of the Insolvency Act 1986 or (being an individual) is deemed either unable to pay its debts or as having no reasonable prospect of so doing, in either case, within the meaning of section 268 of the Insolvency Act 1986 or (being a partnership) has any partner to whom any of the foregoing apply;
 - c) the Supplier commences negotiations with all or any class of its creditors with a view to rescheduling any of its debts, or makes a proposal for or enters into any compromise or arrangement with its creditors other than (where a company) for the sole purpose of a scheme for a solvent amalgamation of the Supplier with one or more other companies or the solvent reconstruction of the Supplier;
 - d) a petition is filed, a notice is given, a resolution is passed, or an order is made, for or in connection with the winding up of the Supplier (being a company) other than for the sole purpose of a scheme for a solvent amalgamation of the Supplier with one or more other companies or the solvent reconstruction of the Supplier;
 - e) the Supplier (being an individual) is the subject of a bankruptcy petition order;
 - a creditor or encumbrancer of the Supplier attaches or takes possession of, or a distress, execution, sequestration or other such process is levied or enforced on or sued against, the whole or any part of its assets and such attachment or process is not discharged within 14 days;
 - g) an application is made to court, or an order is made, for the appointment of an administrator or if a notice of intention to appoint an administrator is given or if an administrator is appointed over the Supplier (being a company);
 - h) a floating charge holder over the assets of the Supplier (being a company) has become entitled to appoint or has appointed an administrative receiver;
 - i) a person becomes entitled to appoint a receiver over the assets of the Supplier or a receiver is appointed over the assets of the Supplier;
 - j) any event occurs, or proceeding is taken, with respect to the Supplier in any jurisdiction to which it is subject that has an effect equivalent or similar to any of the events mentioned in clauses 16.1 (b) to (j) (inclusive);
 - k) the Supplier suspends or threatens to suspend, or ceases or threatens to cease to carry on, all or a substantial part of its business; or
 - the Supplier (being an individual) dies or, by reason of illness or incapacity (whether mental or physical), is incapable of managing his own affairs or becomes a patient under any mental health legislation.

17.2 Without limiting its other rights or remedies, either party may terminate the Contract:

- a) in respect of the supply of Services, by giving the Supplier 1 months written notice; and
- b) in respect of the supply of Goods, with immediate effect by giving written notice to the Supplier, in which case Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. shall pay the Supplier fair and reasonable compensation for any work in progress on any other Goods at the date of termination but such compensation shall not include loss of anticipated profits or any consequential loss.
- 17.2 In any of the circumstances in these Conditions in which Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may terminate the Contract, where both Goods and Services are supplied, Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may instead terminate part of the Contract in respect of the Goods, or in respect of the Services, and the Contract shall continue in respect of the remaining supply.

18 CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION

- 18.1 On termination of the Contract or any part of it for any reason:
 - a) where the Services are terminated, the Supplier shall immediately deliver to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. all Deliverables, whether or not then complete, and return all Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. Materials. If the Supplier fails to do so, then Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. may without limiting its other rights or remedies enter the Supplier's premises and take possession of them. Until they have been returned or delivered, the Supplier shall be solely responsible for their safe keeping and will not use them for any purpose not connected with this Contract;
 b) the accrued rights and remedies of the Parties as at termination shall not be affected, including the right to claim
 - damages in respect of any breach of the Contract which existed at or before the date of termination; and
 clauses which expressly or by implication have effect after termination shall continue in full force and effect.

19 WAIVER AND CUMULATIVE REMEDIES

- 19.1 A waiver of any right under the Contract is only effective if it is in writing and shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach or default. No failure or delay by a Party in exercising any right or remedy under the Contract or by law shall constitute a waiver of that or any other right or remedy, nor preclude or restrict its further exercise. No single or partial exercise of such right or remedy shall preclude or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right.
- 19.2 Unless specifically provided otherwise, rights arising under the Contract are cumulative and do not exclude rights provided by law.

20. NOTICES

- 20.1 Any notice or other communication given under or pursuant to this Contract must be given in writing and must be delivered in person or sent by post. Communications must be sent to the address for communications given in the Purchase Order (which may be altered at any time by the altering Party giving the other Party 15 day's notice of a changed address). Communications to Advanced Witness Systems Ltd. must be sent to the address given for the buyer contact in the Purchase Order and not to the address for invoices.
- 20.2 A notice or communication shall be deemed to have been received 3 days after posting in the case of first class delivery and 5 days after posting in the case of second class delivery unless the receiving party proves otherwise.
- 20.3 This clause 19 shall not apply to the service of any proceedings or other documents in any legal action. For the purposes of this clause, "writing" shall not include e-mails and for the avoidance of doubt notice given under this Contract shall not be validly served if sent by e-mail

21. GOVERNING LAW

21.1 Unless the Purchase Order specifies otherwise, this Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
